1. Kolkata city became the first one to get a floating market in January 2018.
2. Kanha Tiger Reserve is the first tiger reserve in India to officially introduce a mascot named "Bhoorsingh—the Barasingha".
3. Arunachal Pradesh is the second state after Sikkim, which is declared as the Open Defecation Free State.
4. Indian Railway Minister, Suresh Prabhu flagged off the all new "Medha" train, which is the country's first 'Made in India' train on March 18, 2017 in Mumbai.
5. The Ministry of External affairs of India has announced that it will soon be issuing orange passports for citizens with ECR (Emigration Check Required) status.
